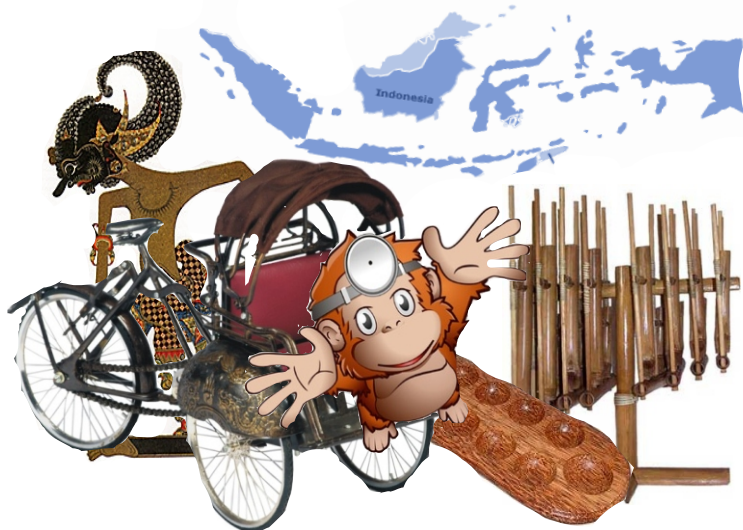

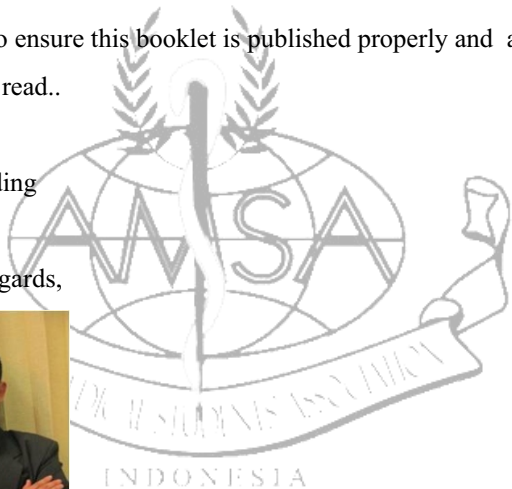



- Action : As medical students, AMSA care about the communities that exist around us and doing activities that are useful and can improve quality of life of the communities where we operate.

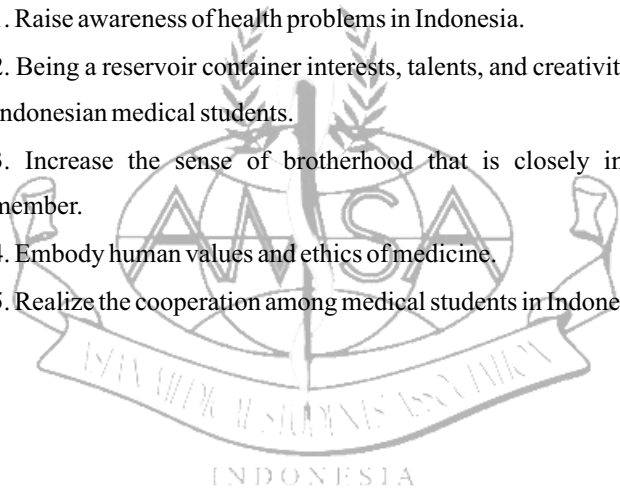

5. Realize the cooperation among medical students in Indonesia



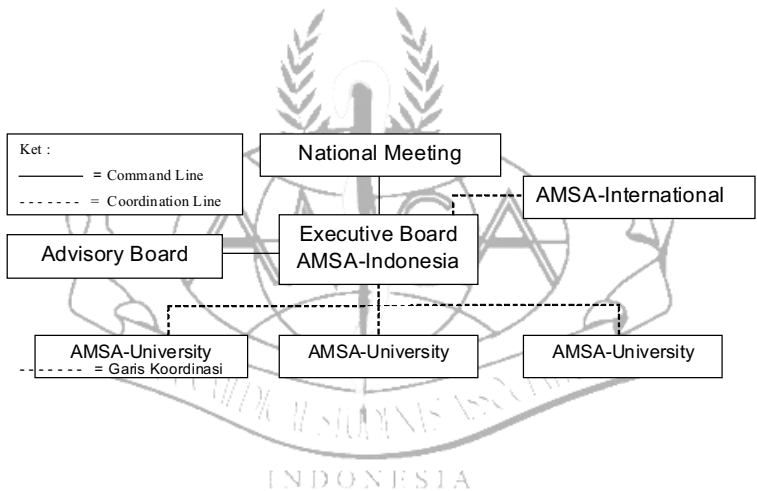

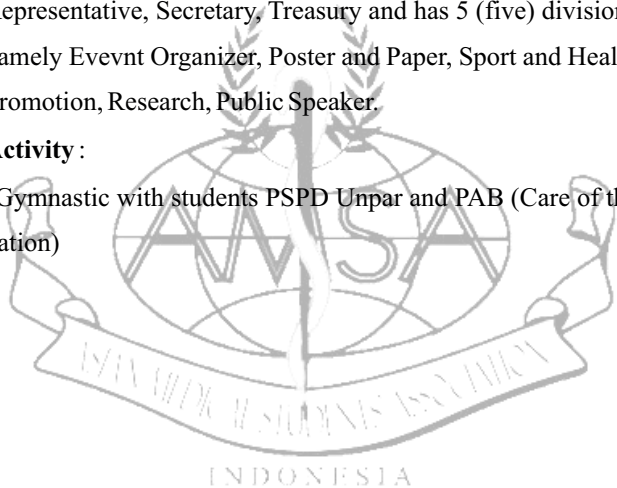


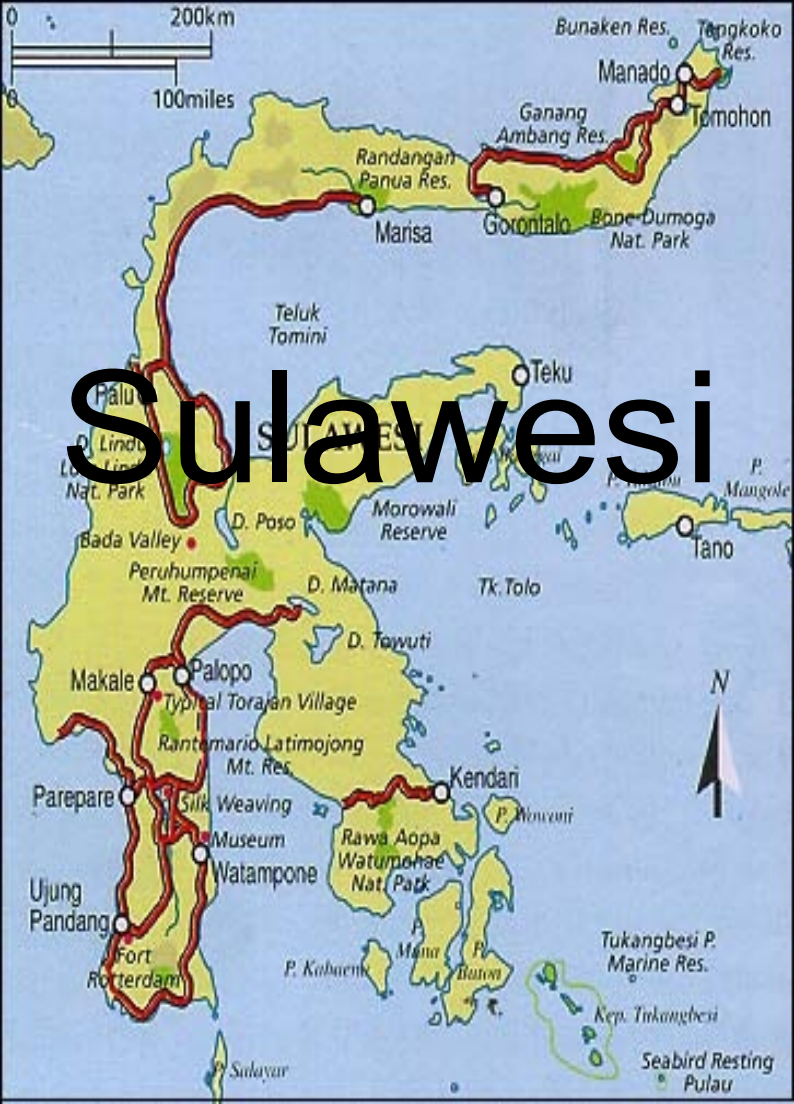
# University of Palangkaraya

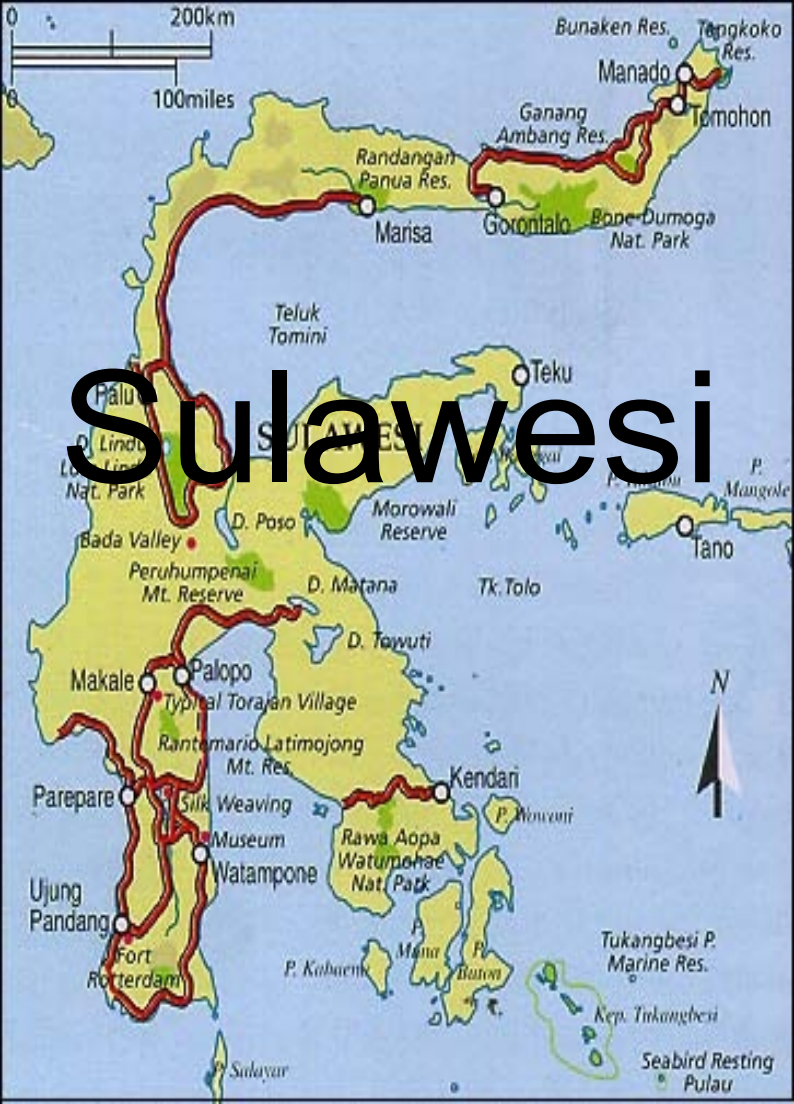

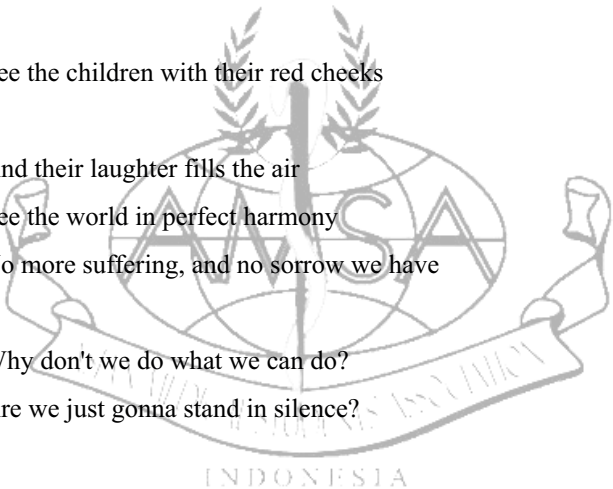

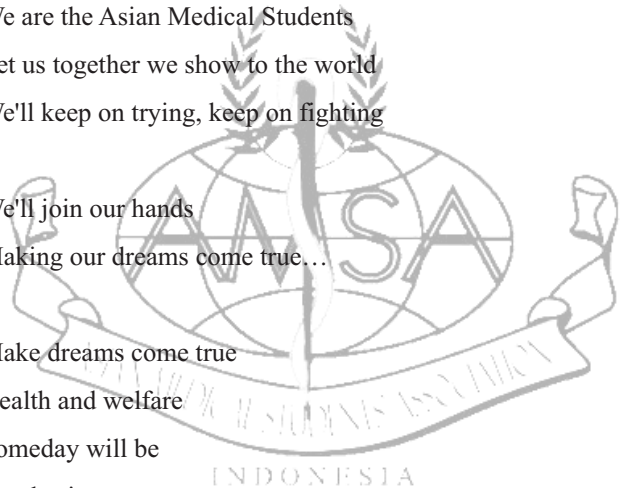
